Permanent Dumpster There will be one dumpster (no individual pick up) location for all of Monarch Cove, near the shed. Dumpsters will get full fast unless <u>we all follow the rules</u>. Lake Bacteria Levels In recent years beaches on Okoboji & Big Spirit have had high bacteria levels/E.Coli closures. E.Coli bacteria normally live in the intestines of healthy people & animals. It causes diarrhea, skin, ear, or respiratory infections, bloody stools, and occasionally permanent kidney damage. To stay safe *and* keep our beach open: 1. Avoid swimming right after heavy rain 2.Try not to swallow lake water 3. Don't swim if you've recently had diarrhea 4. Check child/grandchild's swim diaper often for leaks 5. Don't let pets and children use the lake as a toilet and/or shower. Thanks!
